## **Industrial Action**

As you may be aware, the NEU intend to take industrial action/strike on the following days:

- **Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2023**
- **Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2023**

The strike is happening because of a national dispute between the unions and the government over pay, and not because of any issues at our school.

I am writing to ensure you have sufficient notice of what this means for your child's education on the above dates. We are attempting to spread the impact of the strike action across the year groups, where possible.

## **The arrangements for Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2023**

- Primary provision is unaffected. All **primary pupils** will be expected to follow the normal times of the school day.
- **Year 7, 9 and 10 pupils** will attend school on **Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> July**
- **Year 10 pupils** will remain in school until 3:15pm.
- **Year 7 & 9 pupils** will be released at 12:45pm.
- **Year 8** will work from home using online resources provided. Pupils in Year 8 who are entitled to free school meals will attend the school site between 1:15pm-1:30pm to pick up a hot or cold lunch.
- All pupils who access the HIVE will attend school on **Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> July**

## **The arrangements for Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2023**

- Primary provision is unaffected. All **primary pupils** will be expected to follow the normal times of the school day.
- **Year 7, 8 and 10 pupils** will attend school on **Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July**
- **Year 10 pupils** will remain in school until 3:15pm.
- **Year 7 & 8 pupils** will be released at 12:45pm.
- **Year 9** will work from home using online resources provided. Pupils in Year 9 who are entitled to free school meals will attend the school site between 1:15pm-1:30pm to pick up a hot or cold lunch.
- All pupils who access the HIVE will attend school on **Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July**

## **Pupils with an Education Health Care Plan (EHCP)**

Pupils in any year group with an Education Health Care Plan (EHCP) have the opportunity to attend the site should they wish. Our SENCO, Ms Lloyd-Trewick and Designated Safeguarding Lead, Miss Tobolkiewicz, and the safeguarding team will be present and contactable on site as usual, on both strike days.
